By 6th grade, Catie was already enrolled in high school-level Algebra. Today, as a high school junior, she has completed six AP courses — earning perfect scores of 5 on every exam — and has taken on dual-enrollment college-level math, including Multivariable Calculus and Linear Algebra. In her senior year, she plans to add Differential Equations and Discrete Math to her résumé, alongside more AP courses.

But Catie's brilliance is matched by her humility and heart.

She has served as a **Teaching Assistant for AP Calculus**, contributed to Science Olympiad and Science Bowl (qualifying for state championships all three years), and earned memberships in both the **National Junior Honor Society** and **National Honor Society**.

 Center's regional high school theater awards.
- In **athletics**, Catie has played club and JV softball and volunteers at youth clinics, promoting confidence and team spirit in younger players.
